Walkers draw a living contour line  
in the landscape of Herzele – as part  
of the ARPIA 2012 art festival

The whole action will be filmed from a helicopter and is a preparation for later contour line walks in rough mountainous areas, like in North England, Scotland, Austria and Switzerland. In those areas the goal is to create permanent “contour line walking paths” that draw an organic line through the landscape. After several years these paths would become visible on Google Maps.

During the happening in Herzele a temporary living contour line will be drawn, which will be filmed from high altitude.

From there a shuttle takes the walkers to the contour line location.

It's a walking path with obstacles, not possible with prams. The whole action will be filmed from high altitude: please wear colourful clothes. Wear walking shoes (rain boots if rainy weather).
